

**VILLAGE OF LAC LA BELLE
PARK PLANNING COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES**

April 8, 2026

Public Works Superintendent Sam Salzman called the meeting to order at 9:16 a.m. at the Village Hall. Committee members present included Connie Cummings and Village Trustee VJ Scully. Village Trustee Erik Mullett and Dan Napgezek were excused.

Approval of Minutes for February 4, 2026 meeting:

Committee member Scully made the motion to approve February 4, 2026 minutes. Committee Member Cummings seconded. Unanimously approved.

Public Comments:

Jo Goralski, N87 W35399 Mapleton Road, expressed concern about naming the pavilion at the community center "Chairman Pavilion." The community center already houses the history of Mapleton within the schoolhouse and she feels another location for the name would be a better option.

Discussion on signage at the Mapleton Community Center:

The committee discussed options on where the signs could be placed at the Community Center. They felt it would be best to meet in May on site to look at the different locations and where the signs will be most visible. Superintendent Salzman listened to the recording from the March 2 meeting made and approved on March 2 was to have the wording "No Hunting" and take out without permit and to change no motorized vehicles to no off-road motorized vehicles.

Discussion on naming the pavilion at the Community Center:

After extensive conversation the committee agreed to name the future pavilion at Pondview Park, Chairman Pavilion.

Discussion on parcels near Monterey Dam:

The committee decided it would be best for Administrator Herrmann to contact the owner and find out what price the owner would sell this parcel for. However, the committee didn't see much value in obtaining this parcel.

Discussion on parcel on Lac La Belle Villa Drive:

Superintended Salzman informed the committee of some concerns from residents on La Belle Villa Drive who have noticed people are cutting trees and grass on the village owned property. Committee decided it would be best to do a site inspection before moving forward with correcting the matter.

Discussion on Tamarack Lake access:

Committee members discussed the possibility of placing a pier and kayak launch on Tamarack Lake. Places to park may be the biggest concern. The committee plans to add this to the list of site inspections. Seeing the location and what it has to offer in person will help them decide what's best for the area.

Any Other business:

Superintended Salzman informed the committee about residents dumping yard waste within Pondview Park. The committee would like Administrator Herrmann to write letters to the residents on Cattail Court about our yard waste center and not to use the park for their personal yard waste dump.

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Adjourn:

Committee member Scully made the motion to adjourn. Committee member Cummings seconded.
